At Busy Brains we offer playful activities that gradually build on the necessary skills every child needs to become School Ready. We incorporate simple, everyday objects to stimulate the child during activities and allow plenty of time for free play, time to explore surroundings and time to interact with peers.

A wide range of theme based activities are on offer, which is rotated regularly and children are given enough opportunity to master the activity / exercise. Children have the freedom to experiment freely with different materials in an attempt to stimulate all of their senses, so getting dirty is a big part of our day. Many of our activities are based on Montessori and Mind Move principals.

Our teaching approach is child centered, and amongst all of our loving staff we try and accommodate everyone's individual needs to the best of our ability. We believe that play stimulates gross motor development which in turn forms a strong foundation for your child's learning to take place. Through play, we work in a bilingual (Afrikaans and English) environment to build a strong foundation for mathematics, reading, writing as well as social and emotional development.

#### Terms and conditions

- Please pack: a sun hat; sunscreen; a water bottle with something to drink; breakfast that does
  not need preparation; a snack (if your child attends full day, the school will provide an
  afternoon snack); a set of clean clothes; at least 5 nappies; wet wipes (even for those that are
  already potty trained); bum cream (if they are still in nappies); 5 underpants (potty trainers).
   Please ensure that all belongings are marked clearly with your child's name and surname.
- Busy Brains Klein Windhoek endeavor to apply maximum safety, hygienic conditions and care at
  all times to ensure the safety of your child, yet cannot be held responsible in the event of sickness, injury of any kind to the child, or loss of goods, including personal toys on our premises.
  This applies both on the premises of Busy Brains Klein Windhoek as well as on outings in and
  around Windhoek.
- Registration fees are transferable between Busy Brains franchises, if you change branches
  throughout the year, you will not be held liable for another registration fee and you qualify for
  the annual registration discount should you move branches in the following year.
- If your child is ill / has a fever/ a contagious disease, please keep them at home to recover
  fully before sending them to school. We will notify you if your child develops an illness during
  the day, so that you can collect them as soon as possible. Please give us feedback on their
  condition and if you are not sending them to school due to an illness, the type of illness they
  have.
- We do not believe in pushing a child academically, socially or in any way, so we will use our judgment when moving them to another class. We aim to keep children in the age group they belong.
- We do not allow any form of bullying or disrespectful behavior towards peers or adults, should
  a situation arise whereby a child needs to be disciplined we follow the time-out principle, a
  teacher will in such a case speak to your child and take them from the given situation for a
  time-out period related to their age.

### Important school fee information:

Signature of parent/guardian

- 1. Registration fees are non-refundable and non-transferable.
- 2. School fees are applicable from January to December (to be paid) even though the school closes for holiday during some parts of the year.
- 3. If your child is absent for a period of time, school fees are still applicable and must be paid accordingly.
- 4. If you decide to take your child out of the school throughout the year we require 1 months' notice or payment in lieu thereof. <u>No</u> notice will be accepted between 1 October and December for the current school year. Please advise us by 1 Oct if you are moving your child to a pre-school the following year.
- 5. The registration fee for the year you are applying for reserves your child's space. If it is not paid by 1 October for the applicable year, or a specific arrangement has been made, we can unfortunately not guarantee a space for your child. Existing students get N\$ 150 discount on the registration fee for the following year.
- 6. Monthly fees are payable in advance before the  $5^{th}$  of every month. Should your fees be outstanding for two consecutive months, your child's place will unfortunately be offered to another child.
- 7. In the case of a 'state of emergency, lock down, limitations on movement or similar amended operating regulations due to a pandemic or other unforeseen circumstances' being called for by the president of the country, and subsequent school closures as a result, other than what is planned for during the school year; the school endeavor to assist parents financially or otherwise to the best of its ability in the given situation, but reserves the right to charge full school fees, as would have been during normal operations.
